Qualifications

- Prior experience as children's ministry director or similar leadership role preferred.
- Professional training in children's education or equivalent at a Bible college or theological seminary preferred.
- Should have a love for children and a commitment to partner with parents to nurture their spiritual growth.
- Should have understanding of and experience with cross cultural children's ministry
- Speak English fluently. Fluency in Chinese preferred.

Job Description

The Children's Ministry Director will oversee the creation, fulfillment and revision of the children's ministry vision. Basic job responsibilities are to establish or enrich programs and curriculum, and be in charge of supplies and resources, budget, and personnel for children from birth through 6th grade.

1. To envision
 - a. To stay current with the needs and trends in children's ministry
 - b. To communicate with the Senior Pastor and other church leaders about the needs and conditions of children's ministry at ACCC and the ministry goals.
 - c. To partner with the Children's Ministry Deacon to lead the development of children's ministry.
 - d. To communicate with co-workers and parents about the short-term and long-term goals of children's ministry.
2. To equip
 - a. To oversee the spiritual development of the children at ACCC
 - b. To develop the children's ministry team through recruiting, orientation, training, organizing, and encouragement.
3. To develop, oversee, and evaluate
 - a. All programs, events, and classes for children from birth through 6th grade
 - b. The curriculum used for all programs, events, and classes
 - c. The process to ensure the safety and security of all children during all programs, events, and classes.
 - d. The children's ministry budget and expenditures
 - e. The parent-support programs and efforts.
 - f. Outreach and service projects to the community involving children
 - g. Support and partnerships with other ministries within ACCC such as family ministry, youth ministry, fellowship groups, missions, and Chinese school.
